Implementation of Credit and Semester System at PG level
2019-2020

1. The minimum degree will be awarded to students who obtain a total credit as follows

S. No.	Name of the Faculty	Total credits	Average marks per semester
1.	Faculty of Education	60	50

2. The credit will be equivalent to 17 clock hours of teacher-learner contact per semester. There will be no mid-way sitting allowed from 100 to 100-credit (minimum) system at this level.

3. Among the total number of credits required to be completed for degree course 100 credits/credits have to be completed. The credits from parent Department shall not exceed 25 % or 10 credit from other parent Department or other Department/Center/Faculty. In addition to that students have to obtain compulsory credits over and above.

Examination Rules

1. Assessment shall consist of at least two continuous assessment and two end semester assessment. Both shall have an equal weightage of 50% each.

2. The teacher concerned shall announce the date for which each assessment assessment will take place. However, the end semester assessment shall cover the syllabus stipulated prescribed for the course.

3. An assessment assessment of 50% marks should be continuous and at least two marks should be obtained for (at) course of 4 credits and a teacher must select a variety of procedures for the examination system:

i. Written Test and/or Oral Test Type (for more than one or two for each session)

ii. Group Paper

iii. Assignments/Classroom activity

iv. Seminar presentation

v. Short Quizzes

vi. Assignments

vii. Extension Work

viii. An Open Book Test (with the concerned teacher deciding what
