1. Title of the practice: Jijau Lecture Series.

2. Objectives:

1. Title of the practice: Swachh Wari-Swasth Wari-Nirmal Wari- Harit Wari

2. Objectives:

- i) Raise awareness about the importance of a clean and healthy environment among society.
- ii) Promote behavioural change to instil sustainable habits related to cleanliness and sanitation.
- iii) Promote moral, social and human values among the students.

3. The Context:

On the eve of “ Ashadi Ekadashi” the Pandharpur vari is organized every year where pilgrims comes from different places of Maharashtra to Alandi and Dehu Pune. The NSS Volunteers given awareness about the importance of cleanness and health hygiene to pilgrims under the program of “ Azadi ka Amrut Mohtosav” .

4. The Practice:

Inspired by Mr. Vilas Lande Saheb, Founder President of Rajmata Jijau Shikshan Prasarak Mandal and the first Member of the Legislative Assembly for Bhosari Assembly, and under the esteemed guidance of Principal Dr. Ashok Patil and Vice Principal Prof. Kiran Chaudhary, students from the National Service Scheme (NSS) participated in the Sant Dnyaneshwar Maharaj Palkhi ceremony.
